#### Position Summary:

Provides direct delivery of service to assigned patients at Rosedale Hospice. Must be currently registered in Alberta with the College and Association of Registered Nurses of Alberta (CARNA). The position also contributes to a safe environment through knowledge and practice of the organization's policies and procedures.

#### Primary Duties and Responsibilities:

- Functions within the current Standards of Nursing Practice for a Registered Nurse as published by CARNA.
- Incorporates the philosophy of Hospice Calgary which is compassionate care for patients and their families.
- Completes the initial Patient Assessment and re-evaluates patient needs on an ongoing basis.
- Assists with developing and implementing a plan of care in cooperation with the patient, the patient's "family" and the hospice team.
- Provides direct care in accordance with the plan of care.
- Collaborates and cooperates with other members of the multidisciplinary team.
- Supervises Patient Care Attendants and volunteers and liaises with Director of Clinical Care in the event of any concerns.

- Current CARNA registration
- Mature individual; excellent written and verbal communication skills; flexible style
- Experience in hospice and/or palliative care an asset
- Strong team member and ability to work independently
- Ability to handle competing demands with confidence and promptness
- Willingness to participate in continuous learning and growth opportunities
- Passion for hospice and family centered care
