Position Summary:

Provides direct care to patients at Rosedale Hospice. Must have current registration with the College and Association of Registered Nurses of Alberta (CARNA). The Registered Nurse contributes to an ethical, safe, and inclusive environment through knowledge and practice of the organization's policies and procedures.

Primary Duties and Responsibilities:

- Functions within the current Standards of Nursing Practice as published by CARNA.
- Incorporates the philosophy of Hospice Calgary which is compassionate care for patients and their families, completes holistic assessment and re-evaluates patient needs on an ongoing basis.
- Assists with developing and implementing a plan of care in cooperation with the patient, the patient's family, and the hospice team.
- Provides direct care in accordance with the plan of care.
- Collaborates and cooperates with other members of the inter-professional team.
- Supervises Health Care Aides and volunteers.

Qualifications:

- Current CARNA registration
- Demonstrates comfort and ability to communicate verbally and non-verbally with people who are under stress and able to assess their physical, spiritual and emotional needs.
- Commitment to treat all people with dignity and respect in a non-judgmental manner.
- Implements care in a gentle, calm, and compassionate manner.
- Separates personal and hospice life and seeks support when needed.
- Enters the dying journey of others and accepts death as a natural part of life.
- Understands the importance of each team member as a contributing equal
- Understands resources available (internally and externally) to assist in assessments and care.
- Values volunteers and understands their role in the organization's success.

Working Conditions:

- Physically able to manage the care of patients including lifting and transferring.
- Able to work safely without direct supervision.
- Able to work 8 hour shifts.
- Works scheduled on-call shifts.
