
The pandemic halted these trips, but they are now back, and this year, we have 4 families with 6 children headed to the "happiest place on earth".

Robin Strathdee was a stay-at-home mom to her two amazing daughters for many years. While home with her girls, she stayed connected with the community through volunteerism.


